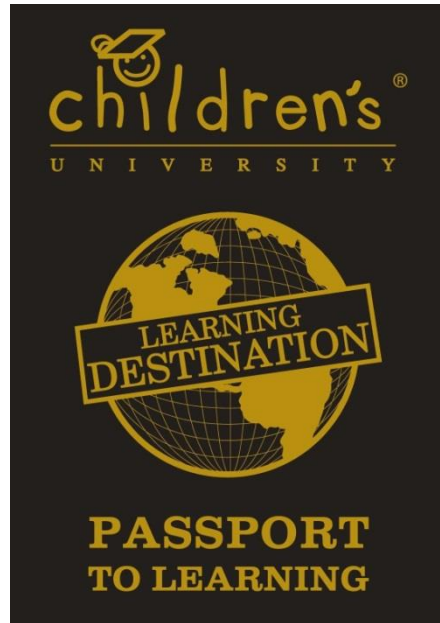
How can I achieve my award?



Clubs outside school...

Check with your group/club leader to see if they may already be a Learning Destination, if not you can give them a Learning Destination Voucher.

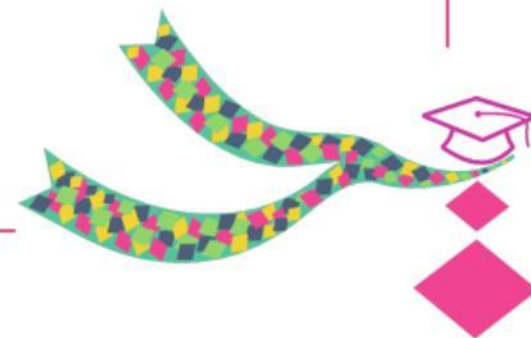
I can collect Learning Credits from venues or providers who have had their programmes validated by Children's University. These venues then become national Learning Destinations.

How many stamps do I need?

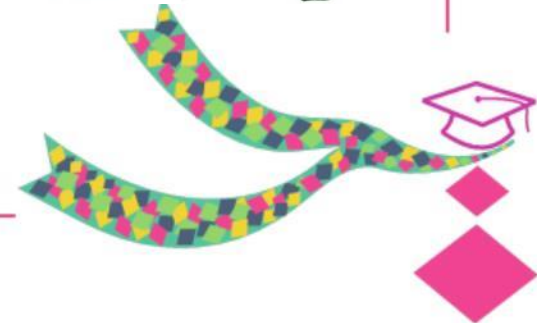
Each CU stamp you collect brings you closer to a Children's University Award, presented at a graduation ceremony.

 Bronze Award – 30 Stamps

 Silver Award – 65 Stamps

He also joined the Dramatic Society where he met Richard Curtis a television writer who he has continued to work with throughout his career.

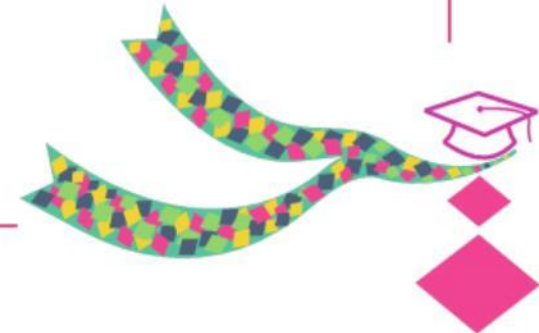

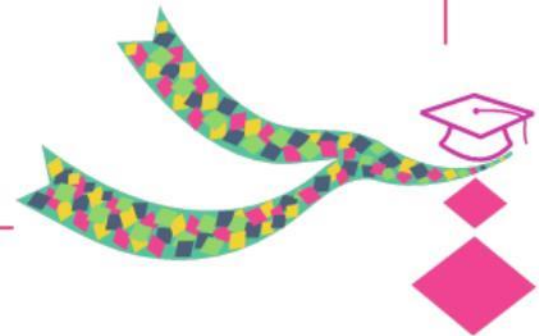
