What we are learning this half term: People who help us

9.1.18 Phonics Workshop

Reading:

This half term the children will be learning about the topic 'People who help us'. Each week they will be looking and learning about different people and sharing information books about police officers, firefighters, teachers and a lot more people. Please continue sharing books with your child at home and some really good questions to ask during reading would be, 'What's going to happen in the story?' 'What's going to happen next?' 'What's happened so far?' 'Why did you like that story?'

Literacy:

In writing the children will continue to mark make and give meaning to their marks. They will begin to do phonics every day in class learning up to 3 new sounds a week. They will learn the formation the sound that it makes and know objects beginning with that sound.

Mathematics

Children will continue to use number by counting out the correct amount to match the number. They will also begin to investigate number problems thinking about how to solve problems.

Topic

The children this half term will learn about people who help us. They will look in turn at all emergency services and will even have visits from special people who help us. The role play area will be a police station which I'm sure they will thoroughly enjoy.
