We will respond to your email.

Please do not use Dojo or any other form of communication for notification of positive cases, as they will not be monitored during the half term break.

When reporting a positive case please state clearly:

- The name of the child and their class
- Who within the household has tested positive
- When they first had symptoms
- Their test date

How we will contact other parents/carers to share information:

Should any children be required to self-isolate because they have been in close contact with somebody who has tested positive for Covid-19, we will contact parents by a phone call with a follow up letter sent via Email to inform them and advise them to self-isolate.
