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Dear Parents/Carers,

It is a fundamental aim of Featherstone Academy that every member of the school feels valued, respected and is treated fairly. We are a caring community. As part of our existing behaviour policy, we are introducing a behaviour scheme called 'Good to be Green'.

'Good to be Green' scheme is an effective way to promote positive behaviour. Every child starts the day on a positive note with a green card displayed in their pocket of the class chart. The card says 'Good to be Green'. If, during lessons or a break time, a child is spoken to by an adult regarding inappropriate behaviour, then a 'stop and think' card will be issued. This warning card gives the child the opportunity to reflect, consider and review their actions. If a child receives a yellow or red card then an appropriate consequence will be put in place by a phase leader or a member of SLT. Every day is a fresh start and every child will start the day with a green card.

We have launched the 'Good to be Green' scheme during a whole school assembly. We have also talked to the children about our three school rules *'Be Ready, Be Respectful, Be Safe'*. As part of our positive school ethos other rewards, such as, 'marble in the jar', 'Dojo points, 'pupil of the week' will continue as usual.

We value our partnership with parents/carers. Parents will be informed where there are persistent concerns regarding a child's behaviour so that supportive strategies can be put in place. Thank you for your continued support.
