School Governor Support

Parents Evening

While it was initially stated parents evenings would take place in the traditional fashion on 10th and 11th of July, our intention is to trial something a little different for our third and final one. Our plan is to now have a much more informal visit to school by parents on the evening of the 11th July. This is anytime between 3:30 and 6:30pm and is an opportunity to look at your child's work in their classroom, talk to their current teacher, meet the new teacher (we are aiming to have any new teachers with us too where possible), have some tea/coffee and some cake in a more relaxed environment. If in addition to this you would like to make an appointment for a more in depth, specific conversation with the teacher, you could arrange this with the teacher on this evening. School Meal Price Increase

From 1st September 2023 there will be a 15p price increase in the cost of a primary school meal from £2.20 to £2.35 per day for paying pupils in Little Learners & classes 3, 4, 5 and 6, who choose to have meals provided in school.

Reception class, Year 1 and Year 2 will still receive free school meals under the universal free school meal scheme. In Featherstone Academy, school meal prices have not increased since 2018 (5 years). The

unfortunate increase is due to natural food price increases and school will be absorbing some of these costs internally.

School Snack and Drinks

Thank you all for being supportive in the changing to snacks at breaktime, this has been a success. One area we are continuing to have issues is where children bring in Prime bottles. Examples of issues had are: children pouring fizzy drink inside, them being lost which results in upsets, altercations between children as to who they belong to. While I understand the current ongoing craze around Prime, please can I ask that these bottles are not brought into school from Monday.

Soccer 2000 sports coaching and after school clubs

For sports coaching and after school clubs we are changing providers. Our offer now includes 2 lunchtime clubs and an additional afternoon sports session in school. These will be spread fairly across the school to ensure equal access. After school clubs in September will run for the whole term and there will be a charge of £5 total for every club, this works out at approximately 40 pence per 1 hour sports session. Class Learning

Take a look at what your children will be learning in class week commencing 26/06/2023;

- Nursery- Looking at the role of a police officer and all the important jobs they do.
- **Reception-** Theme Under the sea. What creatures live under the sea.
- Year 1- In science we will be answering the question and conducting an experiment to decide
 whether people with longer legs can jump the furthest. In PE we will be practicing our throwing
 skills and changing direction

- Year 2- Science, Year 2 will be observing how temperature has affected their cress growth. They
 will be writing down their observations and checking to see if their predictions were correct. In
 Reading, children will be continuing to read Fantastic Mr Fox and using explanation and
 inference skills. In PSHE, we will be discussing what it means to be a good friend and how to
 make good choices.
- Year 3- Assessments in Maths, Reading, Punctuation and Grammar. In the afternoons, we will be investigating our big science question: 'How can we protect an egg when dropped from a height?' Completing our Geography topic of Fairtrade as well as exploring our Art unit.
- Year 4- Vipers- The Miraculous Adventures of Edward Tulane Science- How can we make a pingpong ball levitate? P.E- Tennis
- Year 5-Science Week- How can we make a toy boat go faster? PE- Hockey Skills, Reading-Getting towards the end of War Horse and using different summarise techniques, such as the rollercoaster technique.
- Year 6- Science Week- generating electricity, P.E-rounders.
