EYFS

We look forward to welcoming you to our **EYFS** Sports Day on the 13th July at 9:30am. Can we ask that all parents enter via the KS2 gate which will be open from 9:15 to allow you to get a seat. The children have been working hard practicing the races. All children will be taking part in all the races, these are: Running race, beanbag hoop race, pushchair race, egg and spoon race and quoit balance race. Please ensure you child arrives to school with their PE kit on a water bottle, a hat and suncream applied if it is hot.

Year 1-6

Sports Day for Years **1 - 6** will be on Friday 14th July. We will begin at 9.30am and events will last for approximately 2 hours on the school field.

The children are all taking part in a rotation of activities, so parents will be able to follow them round 6 different stations: Track, Javelin, Discus, Shot Put, Long Jump and Hoop Ring Throw. Children will be sat in classes at all times. We will then come together for special sprint races: Y1/2 sprint, Y3/4 sprint, Y5/6 sprint and then the finale will be a Parent/Staff sprint!

Our kitchen will be providing refreshments for parents on the day, in an area away from the field.

Year 6 Transition Day to Cheslyn Hay 4th & 5th June

On Tuesday 4th and Wednesday 5th June our Year 6 children who will be starting Cheslyn Hay in September will have transition days. Parents are responsible for taking their child on the day, therefore if younger siblings are late to school, they will not be marked as late on these two days.

Parents Evening

While it was initially stated parents evenings would take place in the traditional fashion on 10th and 11th of July, our intention is to trial something a little different for our third and final one. Our plan is to now have a much more informal visit to school by parents on the evening of the 11th July. This is anytime between 3:30 and 6:30pm and is an opportunity to look at your child's work in their classroom, talk to their current teacher, meet the new teacher (we are aiming to have any new teachers with us too where possible), have some tea/coffee and some cake in a more relaxed environment. Soccer 2000 sports coaching and after school clubs

For sports coaching and after school clubs we are changing providers. Our offer now includes 2 lunchtime clubs and an additional afternoon sports session in school. These will be spread fairly across the school to ensure equal access. After school clubs in September will run for the whole term and there will be a charge of £5 total for every club, this works out at approximately 40 pence per 1 hour sports session. Class Learning

Take a look at what your children will be learning in class week commencing 03/07/2023;

- **Nursery-** Road Safety- looking at the green cross code, a visit from a patrol officer, constructing roads and making road signs.
- Reception- Looking after our oceans, how to care for our oceans, recycling and not littering.
- Year 1- English we will be using a stimulus to write a piece of descriptive writing and adjectives will be used. In Maths we are learning about time we will be looking at how to tell the time by the hour and half hour. In the afternoons in PSHE we will be learning about our friendships and how to be good friends.
- Year 2- In PSHE, children will be talking about the different types of relationships they have and why they are important to them. In Maths, children will be learning how to use directional language. In English, children will be looking at different types of performance poetry.
- Year 3-English: creative writing with a focus on high quality description through vocabulary choices. Maths: Properties of shapes. Art: The artist William Morris and using printing to create repetitive patterns.
- Year 4- Vipers- The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane English- Performance poetry Maths-Statistics
- Year 5-DT: Cooking- Designing, Planning and cooking a spaghetti bolognaise. Writing: Performance Poetry Maths: Volume and Units of Measurement
- Year 6- English Descriptive writing, PE Rounders, Science Evolution
