
Free School Meal Vouchers

Class Learning

Nursery: Next week we are learning about the true meaning of Christmas and reading the Nativity story. we will also be making Christmas crafts and practicing for our Christmas play

Reception: Looking at the Christmas Story, we will talk about what we know about it and why some people celebrate Christmas.

Class 1: In Maths we be using part-whole models to explore the composition of numbers and will identify how the numbers are made. The children will continue to identify ten and ones as well as practicing our formation of numbers. In English we will be continuing with the story Aliens love underpants and we will be exploring new vocabulary from our story. The children will define the key words and we will be using these in our sentences. In Geography we will be learning about our Local Area. We will identify the human and physical features of our area as well as using a compass to navigate different directions. The children will be creating maps of the local area and using a key to identify the different features

Class 2: In Year 2 next week we will continue to look at poetry and write our own acrostic poem about fireworks. In Maths, we will be counting the vertices of 2D shapes and begin to explore 3D shapes. In D&T we will be making and decorating our mechanical monsters.

Class 3: Math's: Children will be looking into shapes and angles including turns. There will be lots of practical activities for them to complete using correct vocabulary such as clockwise, anti-clockwise, quarter turns, half turns and full turns. They will be able to create their own mazes and give instructions to help the mouse escape the maze. Music: Children will be using Glockenspiels all week and learn to play to the right tempo and Rythm by reading the notes off of sheet music. They will also be doing a lot of practicing for their amazing Christmas concert. PSHE: Children will continue to look into 'Celebrating Differences'. The importance of families, conflicts and how to resolve these situations. Writing: Children will be writing their stories based on a historical setting (The Iron Man getting transported to the Stone Age). They will be using prepositions, expanded noun phrases and adjectives, as well as making sure they have used the correct punctuation and writing questions.

Class 4: English- Charlie and the Chocolate Factory- writing instructions on how to make chocolate. Reading- Charlie and the Chocolate Factory- summarising, retrieval, inference and vocabulary. PSHE-Celebrating Differences. Music- learning how to play the glockenspiel.

Class 5: In Year 5, Children will be writing stories that build suspense and tension. In RE, children will be looking at how peace is viewed throughout different religions. In Spanish, children will be continuing to learn how to describe their family.

Class 6: Next week in year 6, we have many exciting activities taking place. We will get closer to the climax of our Wonder book in reading and will plan and write a predictive chapter for the book in English. In Maths, year 6 will explore decimal, fraction and percentage equivalents and begin to find a percentage of a number. In Science, children will carry out their own investigation on electricity, making prediction and testing out their ideas. In Spanish, we will explore how to give our opinion and say what we like and dislike - linking this to school life. In Computing, we will be exploring different aspects of e-safety such as fake news, bias within certain news stories and cyber bullying. We will also explore how to be respectful online as well as who you can speak to if you have a problem online.


