## Year 1 RWI Parents Workshop- 15th April

On the Monday 15th April Miss Smith and Mrs Steatham will be hosting a RWI parents workshop and this will start at 3:30pm. This session is especially for Year 1 parents on the Set 2 and 3 sounds that children learn and nonsense words. Within the lesson, word reading will be shared and strategies you can use to help. You will be shown what a speed sound lesson is and the key phrases that are used. This meeting we will also be sharing about the phonics screening test which the children will be sitting in summer term.

## Class Learning

Nursery: Looking at Easter-making cards, Easter bonnet parade. Carrying on with our mini beasts topic -looking at caterpillars.

Reception: The Snail and the Whale- This week we will look at animals that live in water. We will learn about how they survive and explore the way that they move around in the water. We will take a look at some animals that live both on land and in the water too!

Class 1: Next week the children will be looking at poetry and the children towards the end of the week will be creating their own poetry based about fruit. In Maths the children will be learning to count in 2s,5s and 10s. The children will also have reasoning questions where they will need to use these number facts to answer the questions. In the afternoon, the children will be continuing to design their windmill and will be producing their final design.

Class 2: In English we will be exploring poems with repeating lines and writing our own. In Maths, we will be focussing on addition and subtraction. In PE, we will continue working on balances and movements in gymnastics.

Class 3: Writing: Children will be looking into poetry with a focus on questions and answer poems. They will learn about how to read poetry with the correct tone of voice and rhythm and then they will write their own question and answer poems, which they will then be able to perform. Reading: Sticking with poetry, children will dive into a number of different types of poems, looking at the different features and pulling them apart to retrieve information and explain. PE: After weeks of gymnastic learning, children will be performing their routines and become PE teachers. They will have a focus on keeping calm through some yoga, using balance/strength and testing flexibility.

Class 4: Maths- rounding to the nearest whole number with decimals, English- free verse poetry, Science-reversible changes.

Class 5: To conclude our final week of the term, Year 5 will be immersing themselves in free verse poetry, in both reading and writing. They will gain an understanding of what a free verse poem is, analysing features and vocabulary, and then moving on to writing their own. Children in Year 5 will continue with their creative writing workshop next week, with author Harriet Goodwin.

Class 6: In our final week of the spring term year six will be reviewing the Varjak Paw they have read, making comparisons with other books they have read. Children will also be writing up their flashback story, attempting to make it even better. In Maths, we will continue to explore ratio, answering questions that apply our knowledge from the previous week. In Science, children will investigate the importance of exercise and how it affects parts of the body.


